

Memorandum of Understanding between the District Government of Matiari, World Population Foundation (WPF) and HANDS Matiari.

Date:

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is executed on 5th of December 2005 in relation to the implementation of the World Population Foundation's (WPF) Life Skills Based Education (LSBE) programme in District Matiari, Sindh, through WPF's local implementing partner Health and Nutrition Development Society (HANDS).

Duration:

The MOU is binding on all parties for a period of one year from the above date with further renewal by mutual agreement.

Parties in agreement:

a) The District Government of Matiari, represented by Mr. Mohammad Ali Shah Jammot, District Nazim Matiari. and

b) World Population Foundation (WPF), of House 93b, Street 44, Sector F-10/4, Islamabad, represented by Mr Christopher John Wardle, Country Representative for Pakistan; and

c) Health And Nutrition Development Society (HANDS), with its Regional Office in Amin Fahim Colony, Dargah Road Hala New, represented by Mr. Abid Soomro, Regional Office Manager, Matiari.

Programme Overview:

The World Population Foundation (WPF) in conjunction with the Department of Education, local implementing partners and volunteers, has developed a comprehensive Life Skills Based Education (LSBE) programme, whose objectives are to:

- Improve the well-being of school going youth by strengthening their communication, health and life skills;
- Build the capacity of local implementing partners, master trainers, volunteer teachers and Provincial and District focal persons participating in the delivery of the programme;
- Increase community awareness of issues related to Adolescent Reproductive Health (ARH); and
- Provide an evidence-based platform for future advocacy on integrating Life Skills Based Education into the standard curriculum of the Government of Pakistan.

General responsibilities of WPF:

In implementing the Life Skills Based Education (LSBE) programme in District Matiari - in line with the Training Manuals and Student Workbooks specifically developed for this initiative (enclosed as Appendix One) - the World Population Foundation (WPF) commits to generating: community ownership of the programme by:

- Providing dedicated staff, training and financial assistance for the programme;
- Leading the liaison with Government and securing official support for the programme;
- Supplying Training Manuals and Student Workbooks for distribution to participating schools (listed in Appendix Two);
- Supporting the training and ongoing professional development of Teachers, Master Trainers, Provincial and District focal persons volunteering in the programme (listed in Appendix Three);
- Assisting the local implementing partner with the conduct of community awareness-raising, advocacy and media liaison campaigns to support the programme;
- Monitoring and evaluating the programme; and
- Promptly dealing with any implementation issues encountered.

General responsibilities of HANDS:

As the WPF's local implementing partner, HANDS commits to supporting the programme by:

- Providing dedicated staff, office infrastructure and logistical support for the programme;
- Supplying Training Manuals and Student Workbooks to participating schools (listed in Appendix Two);
- Facilitating ongoing Professional Development Forums (PDF) for Teachers volunteering in the programme (also listed in Appendix Two); and
- Conducting community awareness-raising, advocacy and media liaison campaigns.

General responsibilities of District Government Matiari:


In acknowledging the value of this initiative and providing support for it, the District Government of Matiari commits to:

- Retain the teachers trained in the programme in their original schools and not transfer them during the duration of this agreement;
- Permit the teachers trained in the programme to deliver it in regular school hours;
- Permit the release of teachers from their normal duties, to participate in monthly Professional Development Forums; and
- Facilitate cooperation and support from District Government and School officials, including the release of Master Trainers and Provincial and District focal persons from their normal duties, to participate in events related to programme implementation.
